CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Anne Arundel County – Board of License Commissioners**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the membership of the Board of License Commissioners for
4 Anne Arundel County; requiring that each member of the Board represent a different
5 legislative district in the county; requiring that the Governor appoint members who
6 have lived in their district for a certain time period; specifying that a member's seat
7 be declared vacant under certain circumstances; requiring that no more than a
8 certain number of members may belong to the same political party; providing that
9 the term of a member continues for a certain number of years and ends on a certain
10 date; providing for the termination of the terms of members of the Board serving on
11 a certain date; and generally relating to the Board of License Commissioners for
12 Anne Arundel County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Alcoholic Beverages

11–102.

This title applies only in Anne Arundel County.

11–202.

(a) (1) **(I)** The Governor shall appoint ~~[three]~~ **FIVE** members to the Board.

(II) THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT FROM EACH LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT IN THE COUNTY ONE MEMBER WHO HAS LIVED IN THE DISTRICT FOR AT LEAST 6 MONTHS IMMEDIATELY BEFORE APPOINTMENT.

(2) The appointments shall be made:

(i) if the Senate is in session, with the advice and consent of the Senate; or

(ii) if the Senate is not in session, by the Governor alone.

(b) (1) Each member of the Board shall be:

(i) a ~~[resident and]~~ voter of the county **AND, SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A RESIDENT OF THE LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT THAT THE MEMBER REPRESENTS THROUGHOUT THE MEMBER’S TERM OF OFFICE;** and

(ii) an individual of high character and integrity and of recognized business capacity.

(2) IF A MEMBER CEASES TO BE A RESIDENT OF THE LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT THAT THE MEMBER REPRESENTS, THE MEMBER SHALL LEAVE OFFICE AND THE MEMBER’S SEAT SHALL BE DECLARED VACANT.

~~[(2)]~~ **(3)** No more than ~~[two]~~ **THREE** members of the Board may belong to the same political party.

(c) The term of a member is 2 years **AND BEGINS ON JULY 1.**

(d) (1) The Governor shall appoint an eligible individual to fill a vacancy during the remainder of the term of office of the individual originally appointed in accordance with subsection (a) of this section.

1 (2) A member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the
2 rest of the term and until a successor is appointed and qualifies.

3 (e) (1) The Governor may remove a member for misconduct in office,
4 incompetence, or willful neglect of duty.

5 (2) The Governor shall give a member who is charged a copy of the charges
6 against the member and, with at least 10 days' notice, an opportunity to be heard publicly
7 in person or by counsel.

8 (3) If a member is removed, the Governor shall file with the Office of the
9 Secretary of State a statement of charges against the member and the Governor's findings
10 on the charges.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the members
12 serving on the Board of License Commissioners for Anne Arundel County on the effective
13 date of this Act shall expire at the end of June 30, 2017.

14 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June
15 1, 2017.
